The Lesser Slave Lake Regional Waste Management Services Commission is currently seeking a full-time Yard/Scale Attendant for a 1-year term (with possibility for extension). The position is based out of the Regional Landfill in Wagner. This position is responsible for the scale operation and yard maintenance of the facility on a daily basis and reports to the Landfill Supervisor.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for controlling the traffic entering or exiting the facility
- Operate the scale software and print off tickets and reports
- Ensuring the facility operates in accordance with the Approval from Alberta Environment and is in compliance with the operations plan and all applicable legislation
- Direct site users to appropriate disposal or storage locations
- Daily site inspections, monitor compaction rates, litter control methods
- Performs duties and operates all equipment used in maintenance of roads, recycle areas, landfill, class II area, or any other facility under the organization's responsibility
- Perform manual labour as necessary
- Undertake all preventative maintenance, repairs, and operation of all equipment
- Other duties as required
