
70/30 by 2025

- City Council approved target of 70% waste diversion by
 2025
- Applies to all sources of waste:
 - Single-family homes
 - Apartments and condos
 - Businesses and organizations
 - Construction and demolition





Who has Green Cart service?

✓ All single-family (up to and including fourplexes)

What about condos and apartments?

- Nov 1, 2017 | Bylaw updated to require multifamily complexes to separate food and yard waste for composting or diversion.
- Building owner/manager chooses service provider and how to manage service for residents.



Green Cart rate

- Fees waived for the first six months
- Billing started in 2018 between January 1
 and April 1
- \$6.50/month





New collection days and schedule

Every week

Blue and green carts collected on the same day



Once every two weeks

Black carts collected on a different day than green and blue carts





Calendar (over 30 versions!)





Your green cart pick-up starts the week of July 17

Look inside for details about your new green, blue and black cart collection schedule.

Schedule #4



Important things to know for the week of July 17

- · Your green cart collection starts.
- Your collection days and frequency of black cart collection are changing. Here are the details of the changes.



Green carts will be collected **every week** on the same day as your blue cart.

Since the majority of your household waste is compostable and may smell, this material will be picked up once a week.



Blue carts will be collected every week on the same day as your green cart.



Black carts will be collected once every two weeks since you can cut your garbage in half by using your green cart.

Black carts will be collected on a different day than green and blue carts so you never have to set out three carts on the same day.

To help you get started, check the calendar on the next page for your new collection days and schedule.






Active reminders – 110,967

Compost Facility


