Some Key Commitments

- Implement a Landfill Operator Certification Program.
- Review and update The Municipal Refuse Management Regulations and guidelines.
- Assess barriers to regional cooperation.
- Consider Code Chapters for composting facilities and transfer stations.
- Explore the benefits of a landfill levy.
- Engage with stakeholders to explore opportunities to reduce organic waste.
- Review all stewardship programs beginning with household paper and packaging.



Next Steps

- Establishing a plan to achieve the waste reduction targets, including the development of performance measures.
- Establishing a Solid Waste Management Advisory Committee.
- Launching the Government of Saskatchewan Advisory Committee.
- Reporting progress on commitments annually.
