




28 MSW Workers Died in 2021

- Significant reduction
 - Fell by nearly 50%
- Downward trend since 2018
- First noted in June 2020








9 Fatalities Since 2018


- 8 Drivers/Helpers

 - 1 struck by collection vehicle
 - 1 collision
- 1 Mechanic
 - LO/TO failure







Worker Fatalities by March 31st








