Set out education




Spot the difference! When you start using your carts, remember to leave 1 m of distance in between other carts, bags, vehicles, and other objects.

This way, the robotic arm on the truck can easily reach and tip your cart.

If your cart is set out improperly, it will not be collected.

Insights

- 1.Continual education is key, videos and Reels are great for educating residents
