- Tires (since 1992)
 - Passenger & Light Truck, Specialty, Industrial & Other, Medium Truck, and Off-the-Road (small/medium/large)
- Electronics (since 2004)
 - Computer equipment, Laptops, Tablets, Notebooks, AV, Telecom, Toys, and Music, Printers, Copiers, Scanners, and Fax Machines. Home Small Appliances, Tools, Lawn, and Garden, Visual Display and All-in-one Devices
- Paint and Paint Containers (since 2007)
 - Latex & Non-latex paint, Primers & Sealers, Aerosol Paint, Solvents & Thinners, and Empty Paint Containers
- Used Oil Materials (since 2018)
 - Lubricating Oil, Oil Containers, and Oil Filters

Used Oil Materials Support Grant

Designed to improve the management of used oil, oil filters, and empty oil containers at landfills, transfer stations, and recycling depots.

Tire-Derived Aggregate (TDA) Grant

TDA is a cost-effective, environmentally friendly alternative to traditional drainage materials used in landfill leachate collection systems. Through Alberta's Tire Recycling Program, ARMA covers 100% of the production cost and partially subsidizes delivery to landfill sites.



Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)

ARMA is responsible for the administration and oversight of the following designated materials in Alberta:

- Single-use Products, Packaging, and Paper Products (PPP); and
- Hazardous and Special Products (HSP)

EPR shifts the cost of recycling materials away from municipalities and taxpayers to the producers and manufacturers who supply those products into the marketplace.

Phase 1 of EPR launched April 1, 2025 with 94% of the population represented.
